Bei dieser Master Thesis handelt es sich um eine Auftragsarbeit für die Alpenmedizin GmbH. Die Erforschung des Blickverhaltens und der Wertevermittlung der OTC-Produktpalette von VIS-ALPIN (Marke des Auftraggebers) und einer Produktauswahl der Konkurrenzmarke EMSER standen dabei im Vordergrund. Dabei wurden insgesamt vier Pastillen- und zwei Nasensprayverpackungen erforscht. Die Hauptforschungsfragen, welche Unterschiede sich bei dem

Blickverhalten und der Wertevermittlung bei den Verpackungen der Marken VIS-ALPIN und EMSER feststellen und welche Empfehlungen sich daraus für die Gestaltung der Produktverpackungen der Marke VIS-ALPIN ableiten lassen, bilden den Schwerpunkt der Erkenntnisgewinnung. Als Methoden wurden die Literaturrecherche, die Blickregistrierungsmethode und ein Online-Fragebogen herangezogen. Die Literaturrecherche erläutert einerseits die Wahrnehmungsprinzipien der Gestaltpsychologie als auch die Bedeutung des Verpackungsdesigns in der Markengestaltung mit dem Fokus auf Pharmaverpackungen. Die apparative Blickregistrierungsmethode wird ebenso theoretisch beleuchtet. Insgesamt wurde das Blickverhalten von 64 Testpersonen (davon 57 valide Recordings) untersucht. Dabei wurden die Pastillen und die Nasensprays beider Marken getrennt voneinander gezeigt. Je Produktkategorie mussten sich die Probandinnen und Probanden für ein OTC-Produkt entscheiden. Zusammenfassend kann anhand der Analysen gesagt werden, dass zwischen den VIS-ALPIN Pastillenverpackungen und den EMSER Pastillenverpackungen signifikante Unterschiede im Blickverhalten festgestellt werden konnten. Demnach wurden die VIS-ALPIN Alpensalz Pastillen länger und häufiger betrachtet. Im Gegensatz dazu konnten keine signifikanten Unterschiede im Blickverhalten zwischen den Nasensprays von VIS-ALPIN und EMSER festgestellt werden. Das Blickverhalten zwischen der Logos und die Abbildungen der Geschmackskomponenten auf allen Pastillenverpackungen ergaben ebenso keine signifikanten Unterschiede. Jedoch konnten im Blickverhalten zwischen der Wasserabbildung

(wurde häufiger und öfter betrachtet) und dem Alpenpanorama beider Nasensprays signifikante Unterschiede ermittelt werden. Den Testpersonen wurden durch die VIS-ALPIN Verpackungen die Markenkernwerte vermittelt und dies im selben Ausmaß je Produktkategorie. Bei den semantischen Differentialen zwischen EMSER und VIS-ALPIN konnte bei mehr als der Hälfte aller Gegensatzpaare signifikante Unterschiede in der Bewertung festgestellt werden. Demnach wird VIS-ALPIN als natürlicher, sympathischer, vertrauensvoller, regionaler und innovativer wahrgenommen. Ebenso werden VIS-ALPIN eine höhere Rohstoffqualität sowie eine bessere Verträglichkeit zugesprochen. Aufgrund der Ergebnisse wird dem Auftraggeber empfohlen, den Figur-Grund Kontrast des Alpenmedizin Siegels zu verbessern. Zusätzlich kann VIS-ALPIN von einer stärkeren Auslobung der ökologischen Werte auf der Verpackungsvorderseite im derzeit vorherrschenden Wertewandel (Stichwort Umweltbewusstsein) profitieren. Prinzipiell kann gesagt werden, dass das VIS-ALPIN Verpackungsdesign den Blick der Betrachterinnen und Betrachter auf das Zentrum leitet, auf dem die unterscheidenden Merkmale optimal erfasst werden können.****This contract master thesis for Alpenmedizin Ltd analyses the eye movement behaviour and the brand value transmission of the OTC-product ranch of VIS-ALPIN (clients brand) and selected products of the competitor brand EMSER. In doing so four pastille packages and two nasal spray packages have been analysed. The possible differences of the eye movement behaviour and the brand value transmission of the VIS-ALPIN and EMSER packages form the main research issue. Afterwards specific recommendations for the packaging design of VIS-ALPIN should be made on the basis of the

findings. To receive proper results, the method of literature-research, the eye-tracking method and a questionnaire were used. The literature-research is dealing with the perceptual principals of the gestalt psychology and the importance of the packaging design in the process of brand design with focussing on pharmaceutical packages. In addition to that the eye-tracking method has been illuminated theoretically. The differences of the eye movement behaviour of 64 test persons (thereof 57 valid recordings) has been analysed. In this process the pastilles and the nasal sprays have been shown separately. The respondents had to choose one OTC-package per product category. To sum up the analysis, there are significant differences of the eye movement behaviour between the pastille packages of EMSER and VIS-ALPIN. According to this the VIS-ALPIN Alpensalz pastilles have been viewed longer and more often. In contrast, there are no significant differences of the eye-movement behaviour between the nasal sprays of EMSER and VIS-ALPIN. The eye movement behaviour of the logos and the flavour illustrations on the pastille packages also don't result in significant differences. However significant differences of the eye movement behaviour could be found between the image of the water (has been viewed longer and more often) on the EMSER nasal spray and the image of the alpine panorama on the VIS-ALPIN nasal spray. The brand core values of VIS-ALPIN have been transported to the test persons in the same intensity. Significant differences between the valuation of more than half of the opposite terms in the semantic differentials of EMSER and VIS-ALPIN have been found. Therefore VIS-ALPIN has been perceived more natural, likeable, trustworthy, local and innovative. Additionally the test persons think that the

resource quality of VIS-ALPIN is better and that the OTC-products have a greater tolerance than EMSER. On the basis of the results it is recommended to improve the figure-background contrast of the alpine medicine signet. Further VIS-ALPIN can benefit from the currently predominant change in values if the brand focuses on the ecological values on the front of the packages. Generally the packaging design of VIS-ALPIN guides the viewers eye to the centre of the packages, where the differentiating features can be registered.
