According to a commonplace narrative, the rise of modern political thought in the West resulted from secularization—the exclusion of religious arguments from political discourse. But in this pathbreaking work Eric Nelson argues that this familiar story is wrong. Instead, he contends, political thought in early-modern Europe became less, not more, secular with time, and it was the Christian encounter with Hebrew sources that provoked this radical transformation. During the sixteenth and seventeenth centuries, Christian scholars began to regard the Hebrew Bible as a political constitution designed by God for the children of Israel. Newly available rabbinic materials became authoritative guides to the institutions and practices of the perfect republic. In the book's central chapters Nelson identifies three transformative claims introduced into European political theory by the Hebrew revival: the argument that republics are the only legitimate regimes; the idea that the state should coercively maintain an egalitarian distribution of property; and the belief that a godly republic would tolerate religious diversity. One major consequence of Nelson's work is that the revolutionary politics of John Milton, James Harrington, and Thomas Hobbes appear in a brand-new light. Nelson demonstrates that central features of modern political thought emerged from an attempt to emulate a constitution designed by God. This paradox, a reminder that while we may live in a secular age, we owe our politics to an age of religious fervor, in turn illuminates fault lines in contemporary political discourse.

Der italienischunterricht in Deutschland hat in den vergangenen Jahrzehnten einen erheblichen Aufschwung erlebt: Italienisch wird in zahlreichen Bundesländern v.a. als dritte und spät beginnende Fremdsprache unterrichtet und kann als fortgeführte Fremdsprache auch als Abiturfach gewählt werden. Bis heute gibt es indes noch keine monographische Einführung in die Fachdidaktik Italienisch, die in der ersten und zweiten Phase der Lehrerbildung als Grundlagenwerk eingesetzt werden kann. Diese Lücke schließt dieser Band, der bildungspolitische Grundlagen des kompetenzorientierten Fremdsprachenunterrichts ebenso berücksichtigt wie empirische Erkenntnisse der Fremdsprachenforschung. Dabei wird insbesondere auf die für den Unterricht relevanten Spezifika der italienischen Sprache wie auch auf Besonderheiten des Italienischunterrichts als dritte und spät beginnende Fremdsprache eingegangen. Zahlreiche Unterrichtsbeispiele schlagen die Brücke zwischen Theorie und Praxis.

The paroxonase or PON family of genes resides on human chromosome 7q21-22 in the order PON1, PON3 and PON2. PON1 was one of the early genes identified as an environmentally relevant gene, in that it is important in determining an individual's sensitivity or resistance to exposure from specific organophosphorus (OP) insecticides. Paraoxonase (PON) is an A esterase (i. e., not inhibited by OP compounds) initially identified for its ability to catalytically hydrolyze paraoxon, the toxic metabolite (oxon form) of the insecticide parathion. Evidence accumulated in the past several years has established that this enzyme, which is present at variable levels in liver and serum of different individuals, is an important determinant of sensitivity to toxicity of specific organophosphorus compounds including chlorpyrifos oxon and diazoxon. Recent experiments have pointed out that it is the catalytic efficiency of PONt together with the levels of PONt that are important in determining the degree of resistance. Surprisingly, even though PONt has a higher catalytic efficiency than PONtQ92 for paraoxon R92 hydrolysis, it does not provide significant in vivo protection against an exposure to paraoxon. Interest in this enzyme has also emerged from the finding that it displays genetic polymorphisms in most populations, with a significant number of the individuals in a given population carrying a PONt gene that puts them at risk for a specific OP exposure.

Compiled by a group of distinguished international scholars including John Pocock, Diana Pinto, Thomas Maissen, and Fania Oz-Salzberger, this volume conjoints Israeli political scholarship with its European and American counterparts, mapping differences and commonalities.

In this detailed study of the republican tradition in the development of the Enlightenment, the central problem of utopia and reform is crystallized in a discussion of the right to punish. Describing the political situation in Europe in the seventeenth and eighteenth centuries, the author shows how the old republics in Italy, Poland and Holland stagnated and were unable to survive in the age of absolutism. The Philosophes discussed the ideal of republicanism against this background. They were particularly influenced by the political and religious radicalism of John Toland, which had survived the English Restoration and was then reaching Europe. Professor Venturi traces the debate on the penal laws and the attempt to relate utopian ideas of society to the practical problem of dealing with man in society, which culminated in the assertion by many Philosophes that an unjust social system necessitated harsh penal laws, thereby rejecting the possibility of reform.
