A broad variety of measures has been adopted to combat the military, economic or sexual exploitation of children. These issues as well as questions related to international child abduction and international adoptions are dealt with in this volume. In addition, the final chapter focuses on children's rights under the new South African Constitution. Four of the seven chapters are written in English. German description: Kinderrechte scheinen en vogue zu sein - jedenfalls in der politischen Rhetorik. Die tatsächlichen Lebensverhältnisse von Kindern - national wie international - sind demgegenüber zum Teil erschütternd. Trotz internationaler Regelungen wie dem Übereinkommen über die Rechte des Kindes von 1990 und trotz partieller nationaler Gewährleistung von Kinderrechten werden Kinder weiterhin als Soldaten in Kriegen eingesetzt und als billige Arbeitskräfte oder Sexualobjekte ausgebeutet. Die im vorliegenden Band dokumentierten Beiträge widmen sich der Frage, wie das geltende nationale und internationale Recht zum Schutz der Kinderrechte möglichst effektiv angewandt und gegebenenfalls verbessert werden kann. Die Bandbreite der Themen reicht von Fragen des humanitären Völkerrechts in bewaffneten Konflikten über Fragen des internationalen Kindschaftsrechts bis hin zu strafrechtlichen Aspekten der sexuellen Ausbeutung von Kindern. Welche Vorstellungen haben Gefangene vom kommunikativen Kosmos im Gefängnis? Dieser Frage geht der Band aus einer sozialkonstruktivistischen Perspektive und am Beispiel einer baden-württembergischen Justizvollzugsanstalt nach. Die medien- und kommunikationswissenschaftliche Forschung zum Strafvollzug fokussierte bislang vor allem die Mediennutzung von Gefängnisinsassen. Die vorliegende Studie untersucht aus einer grundlegenden Perspektive, welche subjektiven Konstruktionen Gefängnisinsassen vom kommunikativen Kosmos in der Haft vornehmen. Aus Leitfadengesprächen mit Gefangenen wurden fünf Typologien abgeleitet, mit denen sich die subjektive Sicht von Gefangenen auf ihre kommunikative Welt typologisch kartographieren und verstehen lässt. Darüber hinaus reflektieren die Autoren ausführlich die Reichweite und die Grenzen ihrer Untersuchung auch mit Blick auf kriminologische Fragen. Die Autoren Prof. Dr. Bertram Scheufele leitet das Fachgebiet Kommunikationswissenschaft, insb. Medienpolitik (Universität Hohenheim). Gerrit Hummel ist und Henrik Rang war wissenschaftlicher Mitarbeiter am Fachgebiet. Arietta Jost, Pia Satinsky und Carolin Wappler waren studentische Mitarbeiterinnen am Fachgebiet.

This festschrift in honor of the work and legacy of Dr. Marc Groenhuijsen provides an international and holistic overview of recent developments in victimology, taking a global scope but grounded in everyday experiences of victims. Its multidisciplinary perspective reflects a range of approaches and practices in victimology, including contributions from the fields of social work, criminology, sociology, psychology, and law. Firstly, the volume introduces new perspectives in victimology, and then analyzes different forms of victimization in countries worldwide. It gives special attention to victims' rights and participation in the criminal justice system, detailing victim-centered approaches to justice through practices such as restorative justice and restitution. Highlighting the growth and development of victimology from a specialization in criminology to an academic discipline in its own right, this book reflects the range of approaches and depth of scholarship in the field. This will be an essential resource to students of victimology, researchers, policy makers, and victim's advocates.

The Ghetto traces back to the medieval era the Jewish immigrant colonies that have virtually disappeared from our modern cities--to be replaced by other ghettos. For readers of Colm Toibin's The Master and Michael Cunningham's The Hours, a witty, moving, tender novel of impossible love and the mysterious ways of art. Johann Wolfgang von Goethe is so famous his servant auctions off snippets of his hair and children and adults recite from his many works by memory. When he was a young poet, his first novel, a story of love and romantic fervor ending in suicide, was an international blockbuster that set off a wave of self-inflicted deaths across Europe. Now seventy-three, sought after and busy with scientific pursuits and responsibilities to the Grand Duke, he has fallen in love with a nineteen-year-old, Ulrike von Levetzov. Infatuated, at the spa in Marienbad, he seeks her out. They exchange glances, witty words. In the social swirl, they find each other. On the promenade, they parade together arm in arm. Time spent away from her is sleepless, and when they kiss, it is in the "Goethian" way, from his books: a matter of souls, not mouths or lips. And yet, his years fail him. At an afternoon tea party, a younger man tries to seduce her. At a costume ball, he collapses. When he proposes nonetheless, Ulrike and her mother are already preparing to leave. Caught in a storm of emotion and torn between despair and unwillingness to give up hope, he begins an elegy in his coach as he pursues her: "The Marienbad Elegy," one of his last great works.

Warum sollten verurteilte Straftäter Theater spielen? Diese Frage wird schnell gestellt, wenn im Rahmen von Theaterprojekten Gefangene zu Schauspielern werden. Doch die Chancen, die sich daraus für die Resozialisierung ergeben, sind weitreichend und einmalig - gerade unter Berücksichtigung der allgegenwärtigen Beschränkungen im Strafvollzug. Das Theaterspielen bietet durch das Rollenspiel neben sozialtherapeutischen Effekten vielschichtige Entwicklungsmöglichkeiten für die Spielenden bis hin zu Wandlungen der Persönlichkeit. Dieser Band zeigt im Rahmen eines kriminologisch fundierten Resozialisierungskonzepts die Potentiale und Schwierigkeiten der Theaterarbeit mit Strafgefangenen im Hinblick auf deren Wiedereingliederung auf.

Das zum 300-jährigen Bestehen der Justizvollzugsanstalt Waldheim entstandene Buch enthält Beiträge mehrerer Autoren zu unterschiedlichen Themen aus dem den Justizvollzug. Die Bandbreite reicht von historischen Aspekten über eine kritische Analyse der Wirksamkeit der Behandlungsansätze im Justizvollzug bis zur Diskussion, ob Freiheitsentzug überhaupt noch eine angemessene Sanktion darstellt. Das Buch fasziniert den Leser durch die Betrachtung des Justizvollzugs aus der Perspektive unterschiedlicher

Professionen und durch das Spannungsfeld der verschiedenen Ansätze. Es wird schnell deutlich, dass alle vermeintlich einfachen Antworten bei dieser komplexen Materie nicht greifen. Cyber Victimology provides a global socio-legal-victimological perspective on victimisation online, written in clear, non-technical terms, and presents practical solutions for the problem. Halder qualitatively analyzes the contemporary dimensions of cyber-crime victimisation, aiming to fill the gap in the existing literature on this topic. A literature review, along with case studies, allows the author to analyze the current situation concerning cyber-crime victimisation. A profile of victims of cyber-crime has been developed based on the characteristics of different groups of victims. As well, new policy guidelines on the basis of UN documents on cybercrimes and victim justice are proposed to prevent such victimisation and to explore avenues for restitution of justice for cases of cyber-crime victimisation. This book shows how the effects of cyber victimisation in one sector can affect others. Originally published in 1974 and the recipient of the Denis Carroll Book Prize at the World Congress of the International Criminology Society in 1978, Thomas Mathiesen's *The Politics of Abolition* is a landmark text in critical criminology. In its examination of Scandinavian penal policy and call for the abolition of prisons, this book was enormously influential across Europe and beyond among criminologists, sociologists and legal scholars, as well as advocates of prisoners' rights. Forty years on and in the context of mass incarceration in many parts of the world, this book remains relevant to a new generation of penal scholars. This new edition includes a new introduction from the author, as well as an afterword that collects contributions from leading criminologists and inmates from Germany, England, Norway and the United States to reflect on the development and current state of the academic literature on penal abolition. This book will be suitable for academics and students of criminology and sociology, as well as those studying political science. It will also be of great interest to

those who read the original book and are looking for new insights into an issue that is still as important and topical today as it was forty years ago. Taking Hollywood as its focus, this timely book provides a sustained, interdisciplinary perspective on memory and film from early cinema to the present. Considering the relationship between official and popular memory, the politics of memory, and the technological and representational shifts that have come to effect memory's contemporary mediation, the book contributes to the growing debate on the status and function of the past in cultural life and discourse. By gathering key critics from film studies, American studies and cultural studies, *Memory and Popular Film* establishes a framework for discussing issues of memory in film and of film as memory. Together with essays on the remembered past in early film marketing, within popular reminiscence, and at film festivals, the book considers memory films such as *Forrest Gump*, *Lone Star*, *Pleasantville*, *Rosewood* and *Jackie Brown*.

Questions regarding how to improve the transitional phase from prison to life in society after release have gained major importance in the last decade in criminal policy. All over the world release preparation and resettlement practice are discussed with the aim to reduce negative effects of imprisonment and re-offending rates. Small and large reforms aiming at the improvement of release processes and reintegration strategies have taken place in many European states. This book describes the current European landscape of prisoner resettlement and brings together the results and ideas of leading European academic experts with the ambition of furthering national, European and international reform debates. This book presents national reports about resettlement processes and structures in 20 European countries: written by national scholars, these reports reveal important actors in resettlement processes as well as political decisions about the role of the communities in "taking the prisoners back", or the use of early release as a strategy to motivate the released prisoner to enter into a future without crime. Thematic chapters then concentrate on several aspects of prisoner resettlement that are of importance across borders: ethical, legal and practical challenges are discussed with a view on European developments, and theoretical frameworks of prisoner resettlement are used to develop comprehensive perspectives for future reform debates. The book serves as a fundamental source for researchers, politicians and practitioners in the field of prison and probation reform and practice. It is also useful in the field of

social work, in so far that the analyses confirm that prisoner resettlement is not just a problem of criminal, but also of social justice. Evan Horne, once a world class pianist, is now a man with a broken hand and a broken career. When former boss, singer Lonnie Cole, asks him to be intermediary in the payment of blackmail, Horne is unable to resist. But trading money for embarrassing photos turns out to be complicated. Pretty soon the money is gone, but the photos haven't turned up. Instead, there's a fresh body on the beach, and Horne is looking more and more like a suspect.

Boris Becker shot to fame in 1985 when at seventeen years old, he became the youngest player ever to win the men's final at Wimbledon. He went on to win two more Wimbledon titles, and a total of forty-nine singles and fifteen doubles crowns, making him one of the greatest players of the twentieth century. But his life off the court has always attracted as much attention as his triumphs on it. Now, in this remarkably candid and thought-provoking autobiography, Boris Becker tells the real story behind the headlines. He speaks of the seconds before the serve that made him the youngest Wimbledon winner of all time, and of the minutes after being sentenced as a tax evader. He talks

about his marriage, his illegitimate daughter, and his painful divorce. He reveals his emotions at the end of his tennis career, and his battles with pills and alcohol. He also shares his memories of the good times, the championship wins, the make-or-break matches, and the highs and lows of life on the international circuit. Boris Becker has written this autobiography not just for his fans but also for his children, that they may one day read the true account of their father's remarkable, and often controversial, life.

Social Contagion presents the untold story of the COVID-19 outbreak in Wuhan. Chuang, a collective of communists living inside and outside China, chronicle the struggles of everyday people caught between a lethal virus and a repressive state. They argue that China's rapid but fragile economic growth has created the social and biological conditions for new and deadly viruses, of which COVID-19 was merely the latest iteration.
