Concise Pali-English Dictionary has been prepared mainly for use by students in schools and colleges. The author is not only an eminent Elder of the Buddhist Order but one of the leading Pali scholars recognized both in the East and West as an authority on the subject. It is to be observed that the author has kept more or less to the traditional sense of words while not altogether ignoring the meanings given by western scholars in their translations and lexicons. Many errors in the latter sources have also been rectified. But the basic sense adopted is in nearly every instance the traditionally accepted meaning in accord with the commentaries and the glossaries. This perhaps is of special value to beginners as thereby they get introduced to the indigenous tradition, thus providing a useful basis on which to build up a more scientific knowledge as the study advances.

The authors of Thoughtful Interaction Design go beyond the usual technical concerns of usability and usefulness to consider interaction design from a design perspective. The shaping of digital artifacts is a design process that influences the form and functions of workplaces, schools, communication, and culture; the successful interaction designer must use both ethical and aesthetic judgment to create designs that are appropriate to a given environment. This book is not a how-to manual, but a collection of tools for thought about interaction design. Working with information technology—called by the authors "the material without qualities"—interaction

designers create not a static object but a dynamic pattern of interactivity. The design vision is closely linked to context and not simply focused on the technology. The authors' action-oriented and context-dependent design theory, drawing on design theorist Donald Schön's concept of the reflective practitioner, helps designers deal with complex design challenges created by new technology and new knowledge. Their approach, based on a foundation of thoughtfulness that acknowledges the designer's responsibility not only for the functional qualities of the design product but for the ethical and aesthetic qualities as well, fills the need for a theory of interaction design that can increase and nurture design knowledge. From this perspective they address the fundamental question of what kind of knowledge an aspiring designer needs, discussing the process of design, the designer, design methods and techniques, the design product and its qualities, and conditions for interaction design.

"Den Elaka System" is the Swedish translation of the short story "The Wicked Sister" which I wrote in 2010 and published the next year. I started learning Swedish about six months after I published it and I was unable to resist the temptation to attempt a translation. As someone who is fascinated with languages and enjoys

learning them for fun, I know I am often frustrated that I am unable to find helpful language learning resources that provide bilingual books in my target languages, except perhaps for books written mainly for children. I would rate this as a B2 level of reading, (intermediate), although the English translations are provided below each paragraph (*note: alternating paragraphs are for e-books only. For paper copies you will find Swedish on one page and the English translation opposite). After you have finished reading the book using the alternating Swedish/English translations, I have provided two more translations of the book for you to enjoy! One completely in Swedish, and one in completely English. So you have several ways to enjoy the story: either following along a small portion at a time and using the corresponding translation for help, if needed; practicing the entire story at once in your target language; or reading the story in the language you are most comfortable in to simply enjoy a good murder mystery or to check your reading comprehension if you read it first in your target language only. The story itself is a short murder mystery and focuses on the plight of two adolescent orphaned sisters and their struggle to eke out a living in the unforgiving atmosphere of New York City in the nineteenth century. As

things became more desperate, they begin to question everything they thought they knew about themselves and each other. Just how far will they go in order to secure the lives they've always dreamt they deserved? What would they be willing to sacrifice to make their dreams come true? Or rather... who?
