Wenn Kinder einen gestörten oder gehemmten Zugang zur Sprache entwickelt haben, kann es ab dem 1. Schuljahr zu Misserfolgserlebnissen und weiteren züngsten kommen, welche die Entwicklung des Lese- und Rechtschreibens belasten. Der tiefere Grund für das Entstehen von Lese- und Rechtschreibschwierigkeiten bei Kindern ist oft nicht in einer angeborenen oder erworbenen Schwäche zu suchen, sondern in dem Bedürfnis, sich in die eigene Phantasie-, Spiel- und Wahrnehmungswelt zurückzuziehen, um sich so vor den sprachgewaltigen Anforderungen Erwachsener zu schützen.
