In Mexico and many other countries, the quality of these products is verified by bioequivalence tests to compare the activity of the patent drug with the generic one. Most physicians need to prescribe fewer than 100 different drugs for their various patients. Therefore, it is much more important, especially in terms of patient safety, that the doctor have in-depth prescription information about a few drugs, than to know a little about a wide range of drugs that he/she may never have the opportunity to prescribe.

His contention is that the meaning of being in Greek thinking underwent a serious restriction through the opposition that was introduced between being on one hand, and becoming, appearance, thinking and values on the other.

From such a perspective, the duty of individuals no longer consists of protecting themselves from society, but of defending it, taking care of a social fabric outside of which no identity can be formed.

Human beings, regardless of age, sex, or state of health, are designed by evolution to form meaningful interpersonal relationships through verbal and nonverbal communication. The theme that empathic human connections are beneficial to the body and mind underlies all 12 chapters of this book, in which empathy is viewed from a multidisciplinary perspective that includes evolutionary biology; neuropsychology; clinical, social, developmental, and educational psychology; and health care delivery and education.
