***The Kingdom of God Is Within You is the non-fiction magnum opus of Leo Tolstoy. The book was first published in Germany in after being banned in his home country of Russia. It is the culmination of thirty years of Tolstoy's Christian anarchist thinking, and lays out a new organization for society based on a literal Christian interpretation. The title of the book is taken from Luke 17:21. In the book Tolstoy speaks of the principle of non-violent resistance when confronted by violence, as taught by Jesus Christ. When Christ says to turn the other cheek, Tolstoy asserts that Christ means to abolish violence, even the defensive kind, and to give up revenge. Tolstoy rejects the interpretation of Roman and***

**medieval scholars who attempted to limit its scope. "How can you kill people, when it is written in God's commandment: 'Thou shalt not murder'?" Tolstoy took the viewpoint that all governments who waged war are an affront to Christian principles. As the Russian Orthodox Church was—at the time—an organization merged with the Russian state and fully supporting state's policy, Tolstoy sought to separate its teachings from what he believed to be the true gospel of Christ, specifically the Sermon on the Mount. Tolstoy advocated non-violence as a solution to nationalist woes and as a means for seeing the hypocrisy of the church. In reading Jesus' words in the Gospels, Tolstoy notes that the modern church is a heretical creation: "Nowhere nor in anything, except in the assertion of the Church, can we find that God or Christ founded anything like what churchmen understand by the Church."**

**In the early 1970s, living in inner-city St. Louis, Paul Gilk asked his friends to explain why small farms were dying. The answers did not satisfy. Years of study followed. We are, Gilk says, entering the dawn of this Green culture simultaneously with the deepening of civilized world disaster.**

This book presents a novel Biblical ethical hermeneutic approach that emerges from an understanding of the presence of the kingdom of God in the Biblical text. The approach is predicated upon the use of speech act theory (abbreviated as SAT) in relation to 'kingdom language' in the Biblical text. The approach shows how the notion of kingdom language, as God's divine activity, is elicited in the contemporary Christian's life by allowing it to operate beyond the world of the Biblical text. In other words, this approach establishes a Biblical-ethical hermeneutic bridge between the text (and its context) and the context of contemporary readers of the text. The alternative linguistic epistemology in SAT considers the principle of the kingdom of God in the past (locution level), the present (illocutionary level) and the future (perlocutionary level). The dynamic equivalences of the past, present and future of the kingdom of God based on an SAT approach to the Biblical text can inform Christian ethical theory and moral action in the present world. It can also provide a new moral sensibility in relation to God's sovereignty and the responsibility of Christians in contemporary society.

If evangelism would not be perceived as an integral part of the calling of a church into a royal priesthood, then, many spiritual challenges would be evident in the life of the corresponding body of Christ. The individuals within the body of Christ and the ministry as a whole would experience spiritual imbalance in their growth and at most unhealthy Christian living and doctrinal challenges. The interlink between evangelism ministry and the royal priesthood calling of the church is the main proponent of this book. Evangelism God's Way, approaches this argument from both theological and some practical insights and provides a fresh comprehension of what, why, and how evangelism forms the core part of a royal priesthood ministry, both at individual and church levels. The book is handy and packed with scriptural insights on how God would develop this understanding throughout the Biblical revelation. It is a must-read for any Christian, a minister, or a church leader, and can be shared in a Bible study setting to enrich the body of believers with who they are as members of this precious calling of the Lord. As it is stated in this book, "the church is only as strong as it is in evangelism", and as one goes through the pages of this book one continues to realise how true this statement is.
