Today's society is increasingly software-driven and dependent on powerful computer technology. It then explores new ways to improve performance: by providing new patterns, improving the data access locality of existing ones, and using both static and dynamic knowledge about program flow. The work combines novel ideas with practical evaluation of the approach on several applications. The advancements also include the first skeleton API that allows variadic skeletons, new data containers, and finally an approach to make skeleton programming more customizable without compromising universal portability.

At the heart of this book is the aim of providing both a vital resource for investigators, and a purposeful voice for the young victims of abuse, unable as they are to stand up and speak for themselves.

Many practitioners are now continuing to expand their reporting skills from appendicular skeleton to include the axial skeleton in trauma. Other allied profession may also be reviewing axial skeleton trauma radiographs, for instance nurse practitioners (such as in cases of hip trauma). Many practitioners initially fear reviewing axial skeleton radiographs, understandably as missing an injury may have dire consequences, but with training, audit and care this fear can be overcome; and practitioners look forward to the challenge of axial radiograph reporting. As axial trauma radiographs can be difficult to review, the book starts with several chapters, to introduce or revise specific axial trauma. This section is divided into six chapters: trauma cases of the pelvis; of the hip and femur; the cervical spine; dorsal and lumbar spine; the facial bones and mandible (15 cases in each chapter); the last chapter being 25 mixed cases. It is preferably to work your way through the book from start to finish; if you feel you need reviewing cervical spine radiographs, then you can flick to the chapter on reviewing the cervical spine and look at the cases on cervical spine. Each case has appropriate clinical history although this may not be the original history in order to anonymise the case. Some of the cases may not have side markers as they have been removed whilst removing patients' OCO details."
