Like many other young men during the Vietnam War, Ed Corlew faced a decision: enlist and have some influence over the course of his military service or wait to be drafted and face involuntary assignment. He volunteered and, with a post-war career in mind, chose aviation mechanics. When his instructor told his class mechanics-in-training that helicopter door gunners had the shortest life expectancy of any soldiers in Vietnam, Corlew didn't anticipate that he'd soon find himself doing just that: serving as a door gunner aboard a CH-47 Chinook, 15 miles from the DMZ, in 1967 and 1968. Assigned to the famed 1st Cavalry Division, Corlew was shot down three times: in the Battle of Huu, the Battle of Quang Tri, and the A Shau Valley. This memoir began both as a journal to record his memories for family and friends, and as therapy: Corlew flew many missions during the war's bloodiest year, in addition to enduring enemy mortar and rocket attacks and jungle survival, and his VA counselor encouraged him to record his memories. Engaging, frank, and full of action, it describes Corlew's many combat experiences, the emotional effects that he suffered, and how his faith helped him get through it.

This volume contains the papers selected after a very careful refereeing process for presentation during the Workshop on Job Scheduling Strategies for Parallel Processing, held in Santa Barbara, California, as a prelude to the IPPS '95 conference in April 1995. The 19 full papers presented demonstrate that parallel job scheduling takes on a crucial role as multi-user parallel supercomputers become more widespread. All aspects of job scheduling for parallel systems are covered, from the perspectives of academic research, industrial design of parallel systems, as well as user needs. Of particular interest, also for nonexpert readers, is the introductory paper "Parallel Job Scheduling: Issues and Approaches" by the volume editors. This book's point of departure rests on the premises that dimensions of the mainstream inclusive city discourse fail to capture in detail vulnerable clusters of society (being women, children, and the aging), the minority clusters (i.e., the blind, the disabled), and migrants. In addition, it fails to recognize the increase of spatial inequality driven by racial and class differences—a factor that has seen an increase in community violence and protests. The focus on spatial inequality has, for a long time, blind-folded urban authorities to ignore exclusion arising out of the same environments created with a notion of creating inclusivity. Hence this book “collapses spatial walls” as it seeks to uncover the true perspectives of inclusivity in cities beyond spatial dimensions but within social realms. The depth of this book's enquiry rests on its critical investigation of Southern African cities' through historical epochs of apartheid and colonialism in the region.
