Maus studies the bloody pawprints of history and tracks its meaning for all of us.

The critical potential of constellations in Benjamin's work and beyond will be of the highest interest for researchers and students in all areas of the Humanities.

The protection of privacy and personality is one of the most fascinating issues confronting any legal system. Inhaltsangabe:Einleitung: Zeitschriften und Kinder - ein Thema, das in der Forschung nur wenig Beachtung findet. Was die Zeitschrift leisten kann, zum Beispiel den Kindern ein Fenster zur Welt zu öffnen, ihnen Wissen und Anregungen vermitteln, darüber findet nur wenig Diskussion statt. Abgesehen von den Interessen des Zeitschriftenmarktes, der hauptsächlich das Konsumverhalten ermittelt, wurde die Zeitschriftenforschung bisher insgesamt und vor allem in Bezug auf Kinder stark vernachlässigt. Das Fernsehen, aber auch immer mehr Analysen interaktiver Medien wie Computer und Videospiele stehen stattdessen im Mittelpunkt zahlreicher Untersuchungen. Generell überwiegen Wirkungsfragen gegenüber Analysen über die Medienbedürfnisse der Kinder. Diese Forschungsschwerpunkte verwundern nicht, hält man sich die starke Veränderung des Medienangebotes in den letzten Jahren vor Augen, die vor allem bei Kindern auf große Begeisterung trifft: Sie surfen im World Wide Web, zappen durch ein sehr viel uppiger gewordenes Programmangebot und spielen an ihrer Playstation oder Gamecube. Lydia allerdings lässt sich von diesen Entwicklungen auf dem Medienmarkt nicht davon abbringen, auf dem Weg zum Bäcker einen Umweg über die Apotheke einzuschlagen, um sich und ihrem Bruder die neueste Ausgabe der an Kinder gerichteten Kundenzeitschrift 'Medizini' zu besorgen. Ihre von neuen Medienangeboten ungetrübte Freude an der Zeitschrift unterscheidet sie nicht von anderen Kindern ihres Alters: Mehr als jedes zweite 6- bis 13-Jährige Kind hat mehrmals pro Woche eine Zeitschrift in der Hand, hinzu kommt bei knapp der Hälfte der Kinder ein Comic-Heftchen. Der auf dem deutschen Kinderzeitschriftenmarkt dominierende Egmont Ehapa Verlag konnte seine verkaufte Auflage in den letzten vier Jahren um 15 Prozent steigern. Wie kann die Zeitschrift vor dem Hintergrund steigender intermedialer Konkurrenz bestehen? Welche Bedeutung hat sie nach wie vor für die Kinder? Diesen Fragen möchte ich im Rahmen dieser Forschungsarbeit nachgehen. Ich konzentriere mich dabei auf 8- bis 11-jährige Kinder in der Lebensphase der 'mittleren Kindheit': Vom lesefähigen Alter bis zur beginnenden Pubertät. Die Kinder setzen sich meinen Annahmen zu Folge aktiv mit den Angeboten der Zeitschrift auseinander, holen sich aus ihnen heraus, was sie brauchen und verwerten können. Das ist oft etwas anderes als das, was Erwachsene in diesen Angeboten sehen. Denn die Bedeutung der Zeitschrift für Kinder unterscheidet sich [...]

Inhaltsangabe:Einleitung: Marketing allgemein beinhaltet die der eigenen Zielerfüllung entsprechende Beeinflussung von Austauschbeziehungen, unter besonderer Berücksichtigung von Kundenansprüchen. Unter Kindermarketing können dementsprechend alle Marketingaktivitäten, die auf die Zielgruppe Kind ausgerichtet sind, verstanden werden. Eine empirisch nachgewiesene, wissenschaftliche Definition des Begriffes Kindermarketing konnte jedoch weder in einschlägiger Marketingliteratur noch in aktuellen Veröffentlichungen gefunden werden. Diese Tatsache verdeutlicht die Problematik des Themas Kindermarketing und wirft die Frage auf, warum keine konkreten Beschreibungen dieses hochaktuellen Themas zu finden sind. Dementsprechend schwierig ist es, Kindermarketing zum Beispiel gegenüber dem etablierten Begriff des Jugendmarketings abzugrenzen. Mir persönlich erschien der Weg über eine differenzierte Zielgruppenanalyse sinnvoll und hilfreich mein Thema: Das kommunikationspolitische Instrumentarium zur zielgruppenspezifischen Ansprache von Kindern anzugehen. Ich legte hierbei den Fokus konkret auf die 6- bis 13jährigen Kinder. Durch diese Analyse kristallisierte sich beispielsweise heraus, daß Werbung heute bereits fester Bestandteil des Kinderalltags ist und Werbung hiermit die Zielgruppe klar erkannt hat. Dennoch sind bisher nur erste zögerliche Schritte in Richtung gezieltes Kindermarketing zu finden. Viele Botschaften richten sich auf Kinder als solche und lassen die Komplexität und Heterogenität dieser sich ständig verändernden Zielgruppe außer Acht. Zumindest legen viele Beispiele aus der Praxis diese Vermutung nah. Kinder befinden sich, je nach Alter und Geschlecht, in den unterschiedlichsten Sozialgruppen bzw. der Einfluß der einzelnen Sozialisatoren verändert sich rasant mit dem Alter des Kindes. Ein dynamischer Prozeß mit vielen unterschiedlichen Ursachen und Auswirkungen auf das Kind selbst und natürlich auf den Einfluß den Werbung auf es hat. Was auf die eine Alters- oder Geschlechtsgruppe durchaus positiv wirkt, kann bei der anderen, die sie während des rezipierens in einer divergenten Situation befindet, völlige Ablehnung des beworbenen Produkts hervorrufen. Wer das früh entwickelte Markenbewußtsein von Kindern für sich und sein Produkt gewinnen möchte, muß nicht nur präsent sein wenn diese in den Schülerjahren einprägsame erste Erfahrungen mit Produkten, Dienstleistungen und Marken sammeln, sondern das gesamte Sozialgefüge eines Kindes mit [...]

The first volume of Benjamin Studies publishes the keynote lectures of the first Congress of the International Walter Benjamin Association, which took place in Amsterdam, July 1997. Its title bears witness to the most central concepts of Benjamin's philosophy of culture. Strongly influenced as he was by Kant, Benjamin never lost his inclination to analyse the components of reality as fashioned by ourselves. Because he was also a materialist, for him the modes of fashioning were shaped in turn by the times and places we occupy in history. As a consequence, Benjamin's theory assigns a pivotal role in the interaction between the world and its inhabitants to the media: language with its plethora of discourses, the arts, and the whole technology of reproduction. The historical and social development of the media is, translated, according to him, into our instruments of perception, and this perception constructs the elements of the world, the knowledge of this construction and the knowledge of the constructor. The self-knowledge of the constructor is what we call 'experience'. Within this broad epistemological framework, the diversity and complexity of Benjamin's project acquires a fundamental coherence and is therefore able to accommodate the temporal volatility of the phenomena of our world. It's not surprising, therefore, that Perception & Experience offers the most stimulating variety of topics, and that the keynote lectures reflect merely an intensification of interest in certain areas within a much larger field of investigation. The texts presented here pinpoint the central preoccupations of today's debates amongst Benjamin scholars, preoccupations which are themselves responses to our own historical imperatives.

The striking actuality of Walter Benjamin's work does not rest on a supposed "usefulness" of his philosophy for current concerns, but rather on the high "legibility" to which his oeuvre has

come in the present. Indeed, this legibility is a function of critique, which unearths the truth-content of a work in a constellation of reading with the present, and assures thereby that the work lives on. Following this methodological tenet, this book approaches Benjamin's work with two foci: the actuality of his critique of violence, a central and unavoidable topic in the contemporary political-philosophical debate, and the actuality of his critique of experience, which perhaps is not as conspicuous as that of his critique of violence but constitutes, nonetheless, the bedrock upon which his whole philosophy rests.

Among their many idiosyncrasies, Adolf Hitler and Joseph Goebbels, the Nazi minister of propaganda, remained serious cartoon aficionados throughout their lives. They adored animation and their influence on German animation after World War II continues to this day. This study explores Hitler and Goebbels' efforts to establish a German cartoon industry to rival Walt Disney's and their love-hate relationship with American producers, whose films they studied behind locked doors. Despite their ambitious dream, all that remains of their efforts are a few cartoon shorts—advertising and puppet films starring dogs, cats, birds, hedgehogs, insects, Teutonic dwarves, and other fairy-tale ensemble. While these pieces do not hold much propaganda value, they perfectly illustrate Hannah Arendt's controversial description of those who perpetrated the Holocaust: the banality of evil.

This is an examination of film-maker Tim Burton's diverse body of work. Ranging from the 1982 short "Vincent" to 2000's "Sleepy Hollow", his work includes animated projects, offbeat fantasies and big-budget extravaganzas, all of which explore his fascination with the darker side of human nature.

Trauma in Contemporary Literature analyzes contemporary narrative texts in English in the light of trauma theory, including essays by scholars of different countries who approach trauma from a variety of perspectives. The book analyzes and applies the most relevant concepts and themes discussed in trauma theory, such as the relationship between individual and collective trauma, historical trauma, absence vs. loss, the roles of perpetrator and victim, dissociation, nachträglichkeit, transgenerational trauma, the process of acting out and working through, introjection and incorporation, mourning and melancholia, the phantom and the crypt, postmemory and multidirectional memory, shame and the affects, and the power of resilience to overcome trauma.
