The *Magia Naturalis et Innaturalis* was a popular grimoire in 18th Century Germany centering around the legend of Doctor Faust, to whom it was pseudo-epigraphically attributed. This book provides valuable support for teachers and researchers but is also intended for engineering students, working research engineers and Master's and doctorate students.
