This extraordinary volume—which includes a listing of the Torah reading cycles, a Bible time line, glossaries of terms and biblical commentators, and a bibliography—will stand as the essential sourcebook on the Torah for years to come.

It was in the year of 1976 that the Lord sovereignly and miraculously spoke to me to begin studying and publishing Biblical teachings to be shared with a world-wide audience. The only things I had on my desk were a picture of my wife and sons, praying hands with thorns, and a calendar. It was such a shocking experience, that I really didn't know what he meant by "clearing the desk." So at first I just moved them around on the desk. Then I heard the Lord say, "I didn't say move them around, I said clear the desk!" So, I took these three items from my desk and moved them to my book shelf. In obedience to Him, I got out a blank piece of paper and a pen and just sat still at my desk, not knowing what to do next. Then the Lord began to teach me the following specific truths about His Word, the Scripture as recorded in the Holy Bible: 1. There is a thread that runs through the Bible from Genesis to Revelation on any given subject that contains the whole counsel of God. 2. When researching any subject, read and record every Scripture passage pertaining to that topic. 3. For every word in Scripture there is a balanced word, i.e. faith and works, heaven and hell, angels and demons, etc. 4. My Word is perfectly balanced. 5. Do not teach anything before you have the balance to that subject. 6. Record the entire Scripture passages and references on each subject. 7. Print out My Word directly from the

Bible passages. 8. The best commentary on the Bible is the Bible. 9. Do not make this a commentary of your teachings but rather of My Word. 10. The Holy Spirit is the primary Teacher. 11. Only use Hebrew and Greek definitions of words to clarify word meanings. 12. The Bible does not contradict itself, so keep reading until the answer is found. 13. My Word is the "plumb-line" of Truth. 14. On either side of the "plumb-line" of Truth there are two ditches: Legalism and License. 15. The Truth sets you free and you are free indeed. What began as one teaching has developed into hundreds of teachings. It is to these principles and directives that I have adhered and have recorded the teachings He has revealed to me over the past 40 years.

Over the years, Outreach Israel Ministries and Messianic Apologetics have had to field the question, Do you believe that the New Testament was originally written in Hebrew? many, many times. Given the complicated spiritual and theological dynamics present within the Messianic movement-one has to really have some courage to say, No, we do not believe that the New Testament was originally written in Hebrew. There is, to be sure, no Hebrew New Testament document or fragment of any kind from the broad Biblical period. This stands in stark contrast to the fact that the Greek New Testament, and fragments of the Greek New Testament, are the most widely attested and accessible work of antiquity-even more so than the classical works of Greece and Rome. The claim that the Gospel of Matthew was originally written in Hebrew, has actually been disregarded by many in Biblical Studies. The idea that there are hundreds, if not thousands, of colloquial Hebrew expressions or Hebraisms contained in the New Testament, so-called proof of a written Hebrew original, can be contested. Ultimately, because of much of the Messianic movement's leaders' lack of homework-there are many ideas circulating about a presumed "Hebrew New Testament" which cannot be substantiated. Sorting through this, sifting through data and noise, and evaluating what is fact and what is fiction-is by no means something easy. While seeking to maintain the inspiration, integrity, and reliability of the Greek Apostolic Scriptures-no one wants to be perceived as somehow trying to discount the veracity of the Hebrew Tanach, Hebrew language studies, or even studies in Judaism as somehow illegitimate.

Yet, there are ideological questions to be asked about the existence of the Greek Apostolic Scriptures, historical questions to be asked about the logic of Hebrew New Testament proponents, and other significant side-issues to be evaluated. As we seek some resolution to these issues, we should each be asked to prayerfully and thoughtfully consider the following statement from Proverbs 18:17: "The one who first states a case seems right, until the other comes and cross-examines" (NRSV). Many of you are likely to have heard some teachings or statements on the origin of the Apostolic Scriptures or Messianic Writings-which have made some presumed "sense" to you. It may be time for you to perhaps consider another opinion as it involves the origins of the New Testament. This publication offers you some information, which you are going to have to weigh into your evaluations, as we consider some of the documented facts regarding the origin of the New Testament or Apostolic Scriptures.

That's Paul's main idea in 1 Corinthians 13, and this study will help you not only to see that in the text but to seek it in your life. The thirteenth chapter of First Corinthians is about having a love strategy. Paul relativizes what we tend to value most (usually our personal distinctives and niches), places love in central view, and summons us to use every power and resource we have for the good of those whom God has placed in our lives. It includes an evaluation of the moral teachings of the present day Church. This evaluation shows that we have not repented nor been converted to the Gospel values even today. We find in the Bible that untouchability as a practice of discrimination existed in Israel at the time of Jesus and that it had its roots in the Bible itself! The struggle of Jesus was precisely against the practice of untouchability prevalent in his place and time. Jesus was not exactly giving an example for the oppressed to carry their cross meekly unto death. He was rather asking them to fight discrimination even if it would cost them their lives! His struggle should become directly relevant to them. They should discover in Jesus their hero, their leader, their God who died for their liberation. The New Testament also speaks of the struggle of Jesus' apostles to keep themselves faithful to the Way he carved out for them. Paul emerges as the valiant champion of the cause of the untouchables as he affirms the equality of all in Jesus. When Peter discriminated against non-Jewish Christians of Antioch on the question of table fellowship, Paul, condemned him. For Paul, such a practice of discrimination went against the truth of the gospels.
