Touching poja things/ idols and deities at home or temple, lighting up lamp should be done with ablutian (mandatory).For example, if you choose Lord Shiva as your favourite deity and you need his full help then, you have to pray her everyday more than the other deities.You can start with Ganapathy pooja daily after taking bath (at least Om Maha Ganapathye/ Namaha - 108 times) or follow the Ganapathy mantras given in this book and then start worship Shiva with Moola mantra, Gayatri mantra, Rudram/ Chamkama mantras or 108 names (Ashtothram)/ 1008 names sahasranama - where Lord Shiva will be pleased and start helping you. This may be continued for 40 to 90 days to take effect where a particular deity or angelic presence to help depending on our mind, body and soul balance. But don't worry as it happens automatically over the period of time.You need one Guru (teacher) for this mostly; if not please keep Lord Ganesh as your guru and start - as guru upadesam is must. There are some necessary things to be followed; but simple! - Better to keep vegetarian diet (Occasionally if you take Non vegetarian during your day/ lunch then fine. But avoid alcohol for sure on poja days). This characteristic of Lord Shiva in to Guru is his incarnation as the supreme or the ultimate awareness, understanding and knowledge. This form represents Lord Shiva as a teacher of yoga, music, wisdom, and giving explanation on the veda-sastras. He is worshipped as the divine wisdom, complete and ready meditation. As per scriptures, if a person doesn't have a guru, then they can consider and worship Lord Dhakshina-murthy & Lord Ganapathy as their Guru. He is found in many medieval temples all over India, such as at the Ellora Caves and Elephanta Caves. He is called Murugu in the Tirumurukā halftruppaal and portrayed as a deity of beauty and youth, with sentences like "his body shines like the sun rising from the jade ocean." It depicts him with six faces each with a function, twojwans, victory over evil, and shrines in the hilly areas devoted to him.
