Delius Klasing is now launching a six-pack containing all six titles in an elegant slip cover to be sold in book shops. In other words: six identical issues with six different covers. New York-based star photographer Martin Schoeller, one of the most famous and influential portrait photographers in the world, produced portraits of all six LMP1 drivers in the FIA World Endurance Championship (WEC) during the six-hour race on the Nurburgring in July 2016: the drivers were Mark Webber, Neel Jani, Brendon Hartley, Marc Lieb, Timo Bernhard and Romain Dumas. This photo project involved photographing the drivers in a mobile photo

studio immediately after they had climbed out of the cockpit of the Porsche 919 hybrid-racing car. Schoeller explained: "I wanted to feel, understand and experience what goes on there... How exhausted the drivers feel after racing, how disappointed they are when they lose and how euphoric they are when they win." Consistently working with analog technology and producing his pictures on film, Scholler has succeeded in capturing the strain on the drivers faces from long-distance races. All six LMP1 driver portraits are now to be presented in Christophorus issue no. 378.

The 924 Carrera was a homologation model built to qualify the 924 model to race in Group 4. One of the great supercars of the 1980s, the 924 Carrera was considered by many to have better handling characteristics than Porsche's flagship 911. The book features interviews with many of those involved with the car at the time together with race stories, statistics, and a unique exposé of component failures during racing.

Born in the Bohemian town of Maffersdorf on September 3, 1875, Ferdinand Porsche displayed unparalleled automotive engineering genius from his earliest years, designing all-wheel-drive cars by 1900. At the age of just 31, Porsche became the technical director of Austro-Daimler, at the time one of the world's largest automobile manufacturers where Porsche designed some of the world's most iconic cars, like the Mercedes-Benz Kompressor and Typ S models. In 1933, Porsche developed the fabled 16-cylinder mid-engine Auto Union Grand Prix race car. In

1938 Porsche began development of the Typ 64. Built for long-distance endurance competition, the Typ 64 is considered the forefather of all Porsche race cars. Porsche captures the Porsche story through entries on the most iconic Porsche cars ever built, from the first 356 to the latest 911, to the mid-engine Boxster and Cayman, and all the front-engine cars including the 928, 944, 968 and Cayenne. No other sports car has achieved the success of those built by Porsche, on the street or on the world's racetracks.
