It is thought to be Shakespeare's first tragedy and is often seen as his attempt to emulate the violent and bloody revenge plays of his contemporaries, which were extremely popular with audiences throughout the 16th century.[1]The play is set during the late days of the Roman Empire and tells the fictional story of Titus, a general in the Roman army, who is engaged in a cycle of revenge with Tamora, Queen of the Goths. It is Shakespeare's bloodiest and most violent work, and traditionally was one of his least respected plays although it was extremely popular in its day, by the later 17th century it had fallen out of favour. In the Victorian era, it was disapproved primarily because of what was considered to be a distasteful use of graphic violence, but from around the middle of the 20th century its reputation began to improve

no amor, se apaixona por uma viúva, a bela Lívia, sendo emocionalmente instável e sacudido a todo momento por impulsões de ciúme na conquista de Lívia. O romance é atribulado por causa do temperamento desconfiado e inseguro de Félix. **A Mão e a Luva** Sobre a obra: *a Mão e a Luva é um romance escrito por Machado de Assis publicado em 1874.* **Enredo:** *Guimar é uma jovem de origem humilde, afilhada de uma baronesa e que deseja ascender socialmente. Ela é disputada por três homens: Jorge, Estevão e Luís Alves.* **Helena** Sobre a obra: *Helena é um dos romances de Machado de Assis. Foi publicado em 1876.* **Enredo:** *Helena viveu num colégio interno até ser incluída no testamento de seu pai o Conselheiro do Vale, que manteve o segredo da filha bastarda até o dia de sua morte. Ela vai viver na mansão da família e conhece o seu irmão Estácio, entre eles desperta o amor.* **Iaiá Garcia** Sobre a obra: *Iaiá Garcia é o último romance da chamada fase romântica de Machado de Assis, publicado em 1878.* **Enredo:** *Iaiá Garcia era filha de Luís Garcia, viúvo e funcionário público, que nela concentrava todos os seus afetos.* **Memórias Póstumas de Brás Cubas** Sobre a obra: *Memórias Póstumas de Brás Cubas faz parte da "trilogia realista" de Machado de Assis. O romance foi inicialmente escrito como folhetim, de março a dezembro de 1880, na Revista Brasileira e publicado como livro no ano seguinte pela editora Tipografia Nacional. O livro retrata a escravidão, as classes sociais, o cientificismo e o positivismo da época. É notado como uma das obras mais revolucionárias e inovadoras da literatura brasileira.* **Casa Velha** Sobre a obra: *o romance escrito em 1906, foi somente publicado em 1944, após a morte do autor. Um padre se instala numa casa antiga, de uma família de fidalgos, cujo o patriarca era um importante político e muito mulherengo. Dentro da trama um casal de irmãos se apaixonam sem conhecer seu laço de sangue.* **Quincas Borba** Sobre a obra: *Quincas Borba é um romance escrito por Machado de Assis, desenvolvido em princípio como folhetim na revista A Estação, entre os anos de 1886 e 1891 para, em 1892, ser publicado definitivamente pela Livraria Garnier. O romance faz parte da "trilogia realista" de Machado de Assis. O livro conta a história de Rubião, um rapaz ingênuo que se torna discípulo e herdeiro do filósofo Quincas Borba.* **Dom Casmurro** Sobre a obra: *Dom Casmurro completa a "trilogia realista" de Machado de Assis, ao lado de Memórias Póstumas de Brás Cubas e Quincas Borba, tendo sido esses dois escritos primeiramente em folhetins. O Romance conta a história de Bento Santiago (Bentinho), apelidado de Dom Casmurro. Ele se apaixona por Capitu e é enviado ao seminário por sua mãe, D. Glória, para se tornar um padre. Quando ele retorna do seminário, Capitu e Bentinho se casam e tem um filho. Anos depois Bentinho começa a desconfiar que o seu melhor amigo Ezequiel e Capitu o traíam às escondidas.* **Esaú e Jacó** Sobre a obra: *Esaú e Jacó é o penúltimo livro de Machado de Assis, lançado 4 anos antes da sua morte e, segundo a maioria dos críticos, em pleno apogeu literário, depois de escrever, em 1899, Dom Casmurro, o mais célebre de seus livros. Esaú e Jacó se destaca por consolidar esta suave maestria no domínio da narrativa. O livro aborda a relação de disputa entre os filhos gêmeos de Isaque e Rebeca. A história é inspirada no livro de Gênesis, parte integrante da bíblia.* **Memorial de Aires** Sobre a obra: *Memorial de Aires é o último romance escrito por Machado de Assis, publicado no mesmo ano de sua morte, 1908. É considerado pelos críticos, como a obra mais azeda a ser escrita por ele, pois contém alguns elementos de pessimismo. O livro é uma possível continuação do livro Esaú e Jacó, pois o personagem Aires participa da história, anotando em seu caderno, tudo que se passa em sua vida; dando continuidade em Memorial de Aires em que o próprio personagem relata seu dia-a-dia em um caderno. O livro é uma espécie de diário, não tem um enredo único, mas compõe-se*

de vários episódios e anedotas que se misturam.

Dizer que Machado de Assis é um clássico de nossa literatura constitui atualmente um truísmo quase despido de sua essência significativa. Porém, na verdade, só esse termo pode transmitir a abrangência de sua obra e sua relação com a literatura universal. Esse fato foi particularmente acentuado pelas pesquisas e pela crítica modernas, sobretudo no século XX, com destaque, cabe notar, aos trabalhos de Eugênio Gomes, passando pelo revelador enfoque que Helen Caldwell fez de Dom Casmurro como o Otelo tupiniquim. A revisão contemporânea percebeu que Shakespeare é, dentre os chamados clássicos, uma das ocorrências mais constantes no texto machadiano e, em nossos dias, a detecção crítica da presença do genial dramaturgo inglês na obra do nosso escritor princeps só faz avolumar-se. É o que torna tanto mais significativa e importante a contribuição de Adriana da Costa Teles neste Machado e Shakespeare: Intertextualidades, que a editora Perspectiva publica em sua coleção Estudos. Ampliando uma investigação acadêmica existente e perscrutando as aparições, diretas ou subliminares, do bardo seiscentista na pena do bruxo oitocentista do Cosme Velho, compõe a autora um volume que, por sua qualidade, se torna referência, não só por catalogar palavras idas e vividas que, de novo e sempre, interrogam o leitor e agitam o seu espírito, como por dissecar a relação intelectual desses dois vivisseccionistas das nossas mazelas de ontem, hoje e sempre.

Richard III - William Shakespeare - Richard III is a play by William Shakespeare. It was probably written c. 1592–1594. It is labelled a history in the First Folio, and is usually considered one, but it is sometimes called a tragedy, as in the quarto edition. Richard III concludes Shakespeare's first tetralogy (also containing Henry VI, Part 1, and Henry VI, Part 2, and Henry VI, Part 3) and depicts the Machiavellian rise to power and subsequent short reign of King Richard III of England. It is the second longest play in the Shakespearean canon, and is the longest of the First Folio, whose version of Hamlet, otherwise the longest, is shorter than its quarto counterpart. The play is often abridged for brevity, and peripheral characters removed. In such cases, extra lines are often invented or added from elsewhere to establish the nature of the characters' relationships. A further reason for abridgment is that Shakespeare assumed his audiences' familiarity with his Henry VI plays, frequently referring to these plays.
