Book 1 - *Stealing Home* Maggie Jennings didn't think she'd ever see Dylan McCormick again. When she was eighteen, he took everything she had to give—her heart, her love, and her virginity—and then broke her heart when he left for college. But now he's back in her life, playing for the Dallas Longhorns, where Maggie works as the team's media director. Watching him on the field is the most exquisite torture—he's a muscled, talented athlete who looks amazing in a pair of baseball pants. Seeing him again makes her want all kinds of things she shouldn't. Dylan McCormick has it all. A pro baseball career, millions of dollars, and a life most only dream of. But everyone has regrets, including Dylan—and his is Maggie. One look at her, and he knows that he'll do anything to get her back. He wants her. He needs her. He's determined to atone for the past while showing her the man he's become because he knows there's no one else for him. But the past has a way of refusing to stay buried, and when secrets surface, their sizzling chemistry may not be enough to keep them together... Book 2 - *Wild Card* Hunter Blake is baseball's bad boy. He's wild, with a reputation a mile long. He's fodder for both the sports and gossip pages, but Hunter has a secret even the tabloids don't know: he's madly in love with country singer Marlowe Story. He'll do anything for her, including staying married after they drunkenly say "I do" at a Vegas wedding chapel. Under the guise of helping both of their careers, he's happy to stay in the fake marriage, especially because his feelings for her are anything but fake. And now is his chance to show Marlowe what they could have. Marlowe might sing about love and fairy tales, but she doesn't believe in happily ever after, especially when it comes to bad boy Hunter. Even if he is the sexiest man she's ever met, and even if their chemistry is off the charts. When she can't seem to stay out of his bed, she convinces herself that she can give him her body without giving him her heart. But their fake marriage starts to feel awfully real as she glimpses a sensitive, artistic, vulnerable side of Hunter he keeps hidden from everyone but her. Because deep down, this bad boy is broken, and only Marlowe's love can heal him. Book 3 - *Caught Looking* Abby Gossman is unstoppable. An Olympic champion, she's now blazing a trail for women in baseball as the first ever female coach for an MLB team. Her dreams are coming true, even if one of them has to stay in the shadows. Because if anyone knew she was dating Jake Landon, an All-

Star catcher from another team, it would ruin her reputation. But then Jake gets traded to the Longhorns, and the relationship is over. As madly in love with her as he is, he won't ask Abby to sacrifice her career for him. She matters to him more than anything, and he'll do whatever it takes to make her happy. Even if it's killing him not to have her in his arms and in his bed. Even if he wants to throttle any other man who looks at her. But Abby can't seem to stay away from sexy, charming Jake, and before long, they're sneaking around. Hot hotel hookups, clandestine meetings after dark, forbidden rendez-vous whenever and wherever they can. Because as much as they're together, it's never enough. But what's in the shadows has a way of coming to light, and when the spotlight shines on their forbidden love, Abby will have to choose between Jake, the man of her dreams, and the career she's sacrificed everything for.

For anyone who has ever sung "Take Me Out to the Ball Game" during the seventh-inning stretch and wondered why we sing it when we are already at the ball game, this entertaining book supplies the answers. And why did this song become the sport's anthem rather than one of hundreds of other baseball songs, such as George M. Cohan's "Take Your Girl to the Ball Game," written the same month? This story, told here in full for the first time, evokes the bright hope of turn-of-the-century America, the backstage drama of vaudeville, and the beguiling charm of baseball itself. Amy Whorf McGuiggan supplies the fascinating details behind the song's beginnings in 1908, when Jack Norworth, a vaudeville headliner and Tin Pan Alley songwriter who had never even been to a game, was inspired by a subway advertisement to create the song that, though a hit in its day, did not become a time-honored tradition until broadcaster Harry Caray and team owner and marketing genius Bill Veeck Jr. reintroduced it during the 1970s. Here is America's game and the American century seen through the prism of one impossibly catchy tune and illustrated throughout with vintage photographs, advertising images, and sheet music culled from America's premier collections.
